Out of 58 neighbourhoods of Riga, 35 have united under the Riga Neighbourhood Alliance (RNA). DeCrises will study the case of Riga City neighbourhoods, involving RNA as a major stakeholder, and will provide recommendations for their empowerment in the MLG system.

It aims to enable recommendations on how local administration with business, science and citizens can stimulate local energy development and supply security as well as decrease dependence on Russian energy supplies.
